BY AFLEET ALEX - CHESTNUT COLT -

This horse was individually selected for Hibiscus Stables by legendary horseman Greg Gilchrist. Greg said, "This horse has excellent balance and conformation. He's a big, athletic, stout horse. And you have to keep in mind that he's only a yearling. Once he matures I expect him to be a very imposing specimen. Afleet Alex is a very successful sire. Having this horse eligible to run in restricted company gives him excellent potential."

At stud Afleet Alex has sired 22 stakes winners. In 2010 he was the #2 Second Crop sire and in 2011 he was the #5 Third Crop sire in North America. Afleet Alex has sired G1-winners Afleet Express (\$835,140) and Dublin (\$438,949) along with Breeders' Cup Marathon (G2) winner Afleet Again and Champion 3-Year-Old Filly in Puerto Rico Cuqui's Love.

This colt has an "A++" nick. Based on the definition, this rating means that this colt is 5915% more likely (an eye-popping 59.15 times more likely) to be a stakes winner than the average horse. Historically, for this mating, the most direct cross of Afleet Alex bred to Saint Ballado mares, has produced 67% winners including 2 stakes winners and 1 graded stakes winner Bizzy Caroline (G3). Bizzy Carline had 4 wins, 3 seconds, and 3 thirds in 17 career starts and over \$347,000 in lifetime earnings including wins in the Regret Stakes (G3) and the Mint Julep Handicap (G3) along with other stakes placings all ranging in distance from 1 1/16 miles on the turf to 1 1/2 miles on the turf.

This athletic colt is by a G1-producing stallion who was a champion on the racetrack and winner of over \$2.7 million. He has the breeding to compete on either surface and at classic distances. He is a registered New York-bred and will run on the Belmont/Aqueduct/Saratoga circuit. He's nominated to the Aspirant Stakes and the New York Breeders' Futurity. He will be trained by Rick Violette.
